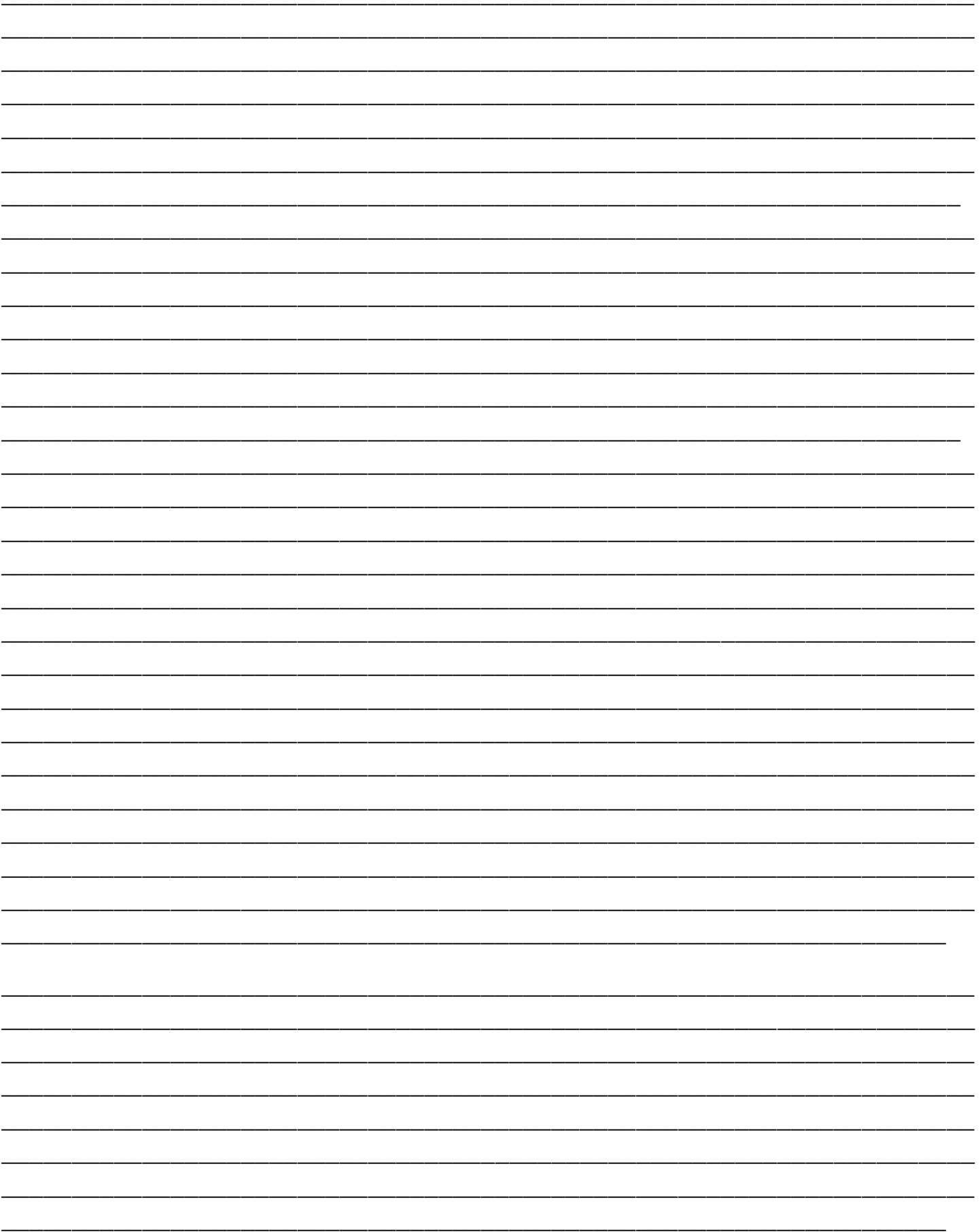

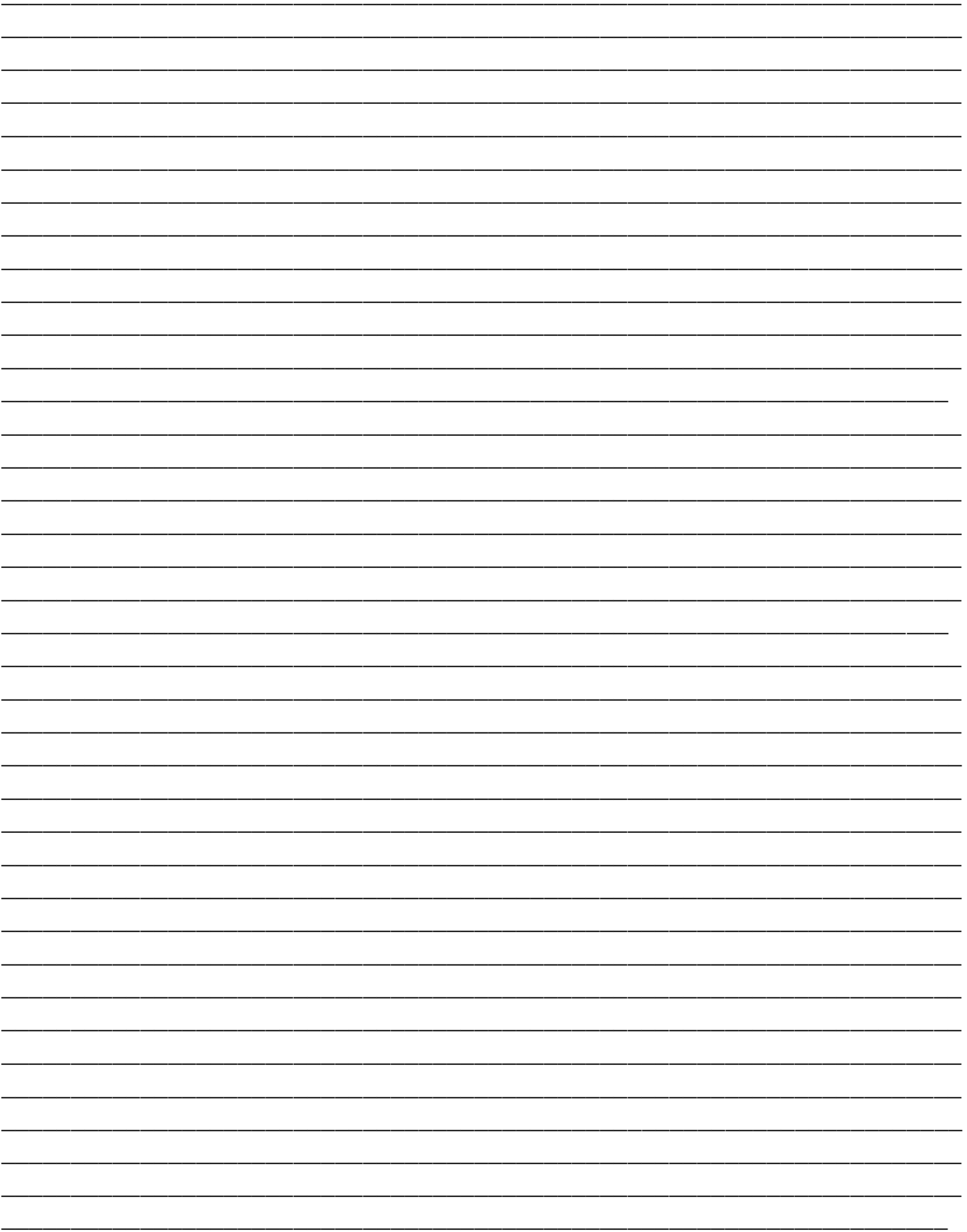

### 1. Where should we turn for strength and power? (Josh. 1:9; Ps. 68:35)

- (Haggai 2:4-9) “‘But now be strong, Ze-rub'ba-bel,’ declares Jehovah, ‘and be strong, Joshua son of Je-hoz'a-dak, the high priest.’ “‘And be strong, all you people of the land,’ declares Jehovah, ‘and work.’ “‘For I am with you,’ declares Jehovah of armies. 5 ‘Remember what I promised you when you came out of Egypt, and my spirit remains among you. Do not be afraid.’” 6 “‘For this is what Jehovah of armies says, ‘Yet once more—in a little while—and I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land.’ 7 “‘And I will shake all the nations, and the precious things of all the nations will come in; and I will fill this house with glory,’ says Jehovah of armies. 8 “‘The silver is mine, and the gold is

mine,' declares Jehovah of armies. 9 "The future glory of this house will be greater than the former,' says Jehovah of armies. "And in this place I will grant peace,' declares Jehovah of armies."

**4. How does Jehovah strengthen us when we face serious trials? (Ps. 18:6, 30; Col. 4:10, 11, ftn.)**

- (Psalm 18:6) In my distress I called on Jehovah, To my God I kept crying for help. From his temple he heard my voice, And my cry to him for help reached his ears.
  - (Psalm 18:30) The way of the true God is perfect; The saying of Jehovah is refined. He is a shield to all those taking refuge in him.
  - (Colossians 4:10, 11) Ar·is·tar·chus, my fellow captive, sends you his greetings, and so does Mark, the cousin of Bar·na·bas (concerning whom you received instructions to welcome him if he comes to you), 11 and Jesus who is called Justus, who are of those circumcised. Only these are my fellow workers for the Kingdom of God, and they have become a source of great comfort\* to me.

- (Matthew 22:37) He said to him: "You must love Jehovah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole mind.'
  - (Matthew 22:39) The second, like it, is this: 'You must love your neighbor as yourself.'

**6. How can we “stand firm in the faith” and “grow mighty”? (1 Cor. 16:13; Rom. 15:5; Heb. 5:11–6:1; 12:16, 17)**

- (1 Corinthians 16:13) Stay awake, stand firm in the faith, carry on in a manly way, grow mighty.
- (Romans 15:5) Now may the God who supplies endurance and comfort grant you to have among yourselves the same mental attitude that Christ Jesus had,
- (Hebrews 5:11-6:1) We have much to say about him, and it is difficult to explain, because you have become dull in your hearing. 12 For although by now you should be teachers, you again need someone to teach you from the beginning the elementary things of the sacred pronouncements of God, and you have gone back to needing milk, not solid food. 13 For everyone who continues to feed on milk is unacquainted with the word of righteousness, for he is a young child. 14 But solid food belongs to mature people, to those who through use have their powers of discernment trained to distinguish both right and wrong.
- 6 Therefore, now that we have moved beyond the primary doctrine about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying a foundation again, namely, repentance from dead works and faith in God,
- (Hebrews 12:16, 17) and watch that among you there is no one who is sexually immoral nor anyone who does not appreciate sacred things, like E'sau, who gave up his rights as firstborn in exchange for one meal. 17 For you know that afterward when he wanted to inherit the blessing, he was rejected; for although he earnestly tried to bring about a change of mind with tears, it was to no avail.
